



IMN NextGen Youth Evangelism Invasion & Family Missions Trip to El Salvador

July 24-31, 2025

Estimated Cost: \$1,950 per person (contingent on airfare)

Package Includes:

- Airfare from Des Moines, IA to San Salvador, El Salvador
- 7-night accommodations
- All meals except travel days
- Airport transfers and transportation to all activities
- Sightseeing trip

Passport is required for travel!

We will be staying at the beautiful **King's Castle Facilities** on Lake Coatapaque, hosted by Don & Terri Triplett. **Youth** will be working with King's Castle local teams all over El Salvador in schools and communities. **Adults** will be doing construction, maintenance, and other compassion projects. The medical team will be conducting clinics at church building sites and other locations.

King's Castle started with a dozen youth evangelizing children in the streets and schools. Now they are active in 60 countries: evangelizing, discipling, and developing NextGen leaders. Their model is, **"Because the children need to know Jesus."** King's Castle El Salvador successfully hosts hundreds of US mission teams, interns, and MAP's workers every year. - 4)** PRAY, think about additional team members and start saving money.

Each individual raises and submits their own funds. (Some churches subsidize 20-25% for youth or first-timers from missions' funds.) As God guides, He provides! Every trip has miracle testimonies! Kirsten from Dexter, IA had someone walk up to her in a restaurant and pay for the whole trip just a few days after she decided to go.

Review above info, collect passport copies, discuss funds due dates - **\$900 check due April 30 to IMN office** (includes \$200 deposit), continue recruiting, continue individual & team fundraising

Team Meeting #3 - May (date/time TBD) @ New Hope Urbandale (or virtually)

Specific groups info (construction, medical, compassion), copy of passport due, AGWM paperwork completion, final names due to airlines on TBD, **estimated \$1,950 total due June 10**

Final prep and packing
